ARTIST'S NOTE

(b. 1957). Creating the book from early every morning for the last couple of months, Kanchan has noted the exact date and time of each work at the side of each page. Incorporating the lyrics of the songs she was listening to while working into the visual image, each page becomes a record of her shifting moods making her book a kind of diary of her lived experience, through the months of its making, where fantasy is mixed with documentary precision.

KANCHAN CHANDER

(b. 1957) completed her BFA (Painting and Print making) from the College of Art, Delhi. She went on to undertake additional training in print making from College of Art. Santiago, Chile, and received a fellowship from the College of Art, Delhi. Kanchan has had several solo shows in India and abroad, including at the The Sandalwood Room (2014, Singapore), Galerie Gondwana (2012, Germany), Art Positive (2011, New Delhi) and Apparao Galeries (2009, New Delhi). She has been part of group shows at Art Heritage (2015, New Delhi), NGMA (2018, New Delhi), Brandeis University (2007, USA), Bonhams (London), Ueno Royal Museum (Japan), and Opera Gallery (London). Most recently she participated in the Print Biennale India 2018 (New Delhi) and Print Biennal-Hangzhou (2016, China Academy of Art, China), as well as the India Art Fair and the Busan International Art Fair (2017, Korea). Kanchan was awarded the BC Sanyal Award (Collage of Arts, New Delhi), Yuva Mahotsava Award, as well as the Sahitya Kala Parishad Award in 2016. Her works were presented at the University of Connecticut, School of Art Institute of Chicago (SAIC) and Mills College in the USA. Kanchan's work has been acquired by the NGMA (New Delhi), Kiran Nadar Museum of Art, British Museum and Victoria and Albert Museum in the UK. Her works have also been showcase in several books, most recently, 'Shringhar - The Many Faces of Indian Beauty' by Dr. Alka Pande. Kanchan lives and works in New Delhi.
